After 1900, the craze for arks waned. Today it is lined with unique and trendy shops, art galleries, high-end waterfront restaurants and casual cafes.

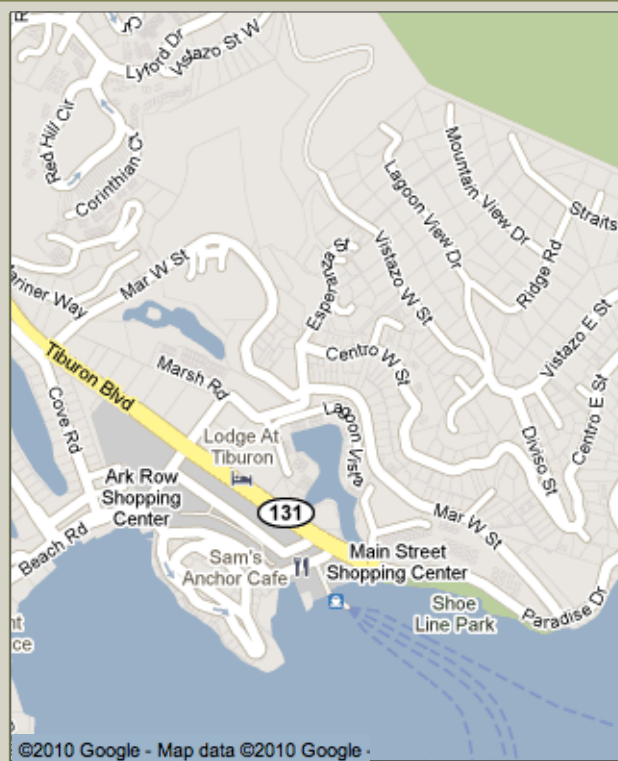
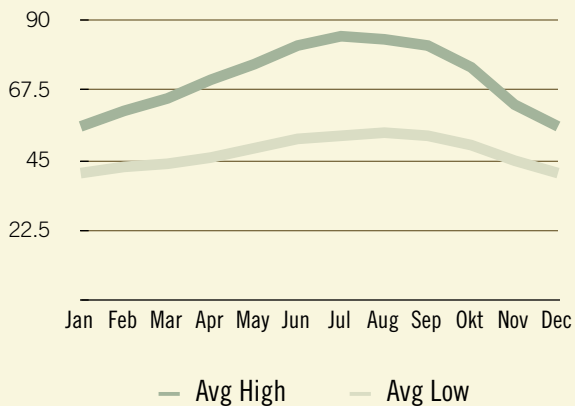

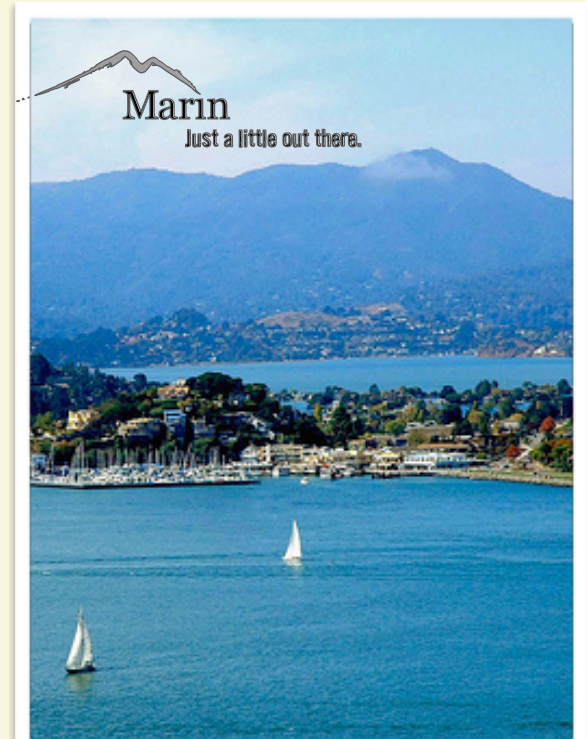

Originally named "Punta de Tiburon" (Point of Sharks) by Spanish Explorers in 1776, the historic railroad town of Tiburon is reminiscent of a quaint New England fishing village. Now a quaint yet bustling paradise on the bay, Tiburon, known locally as "The Sunny Side of the Bay," is a picturesque bayside town blessed with plentiful marinas, yacht clubs, tennis courts and swimming facilities.

THINGS TO DO

Angel Island State Park

San Francisco Bay ~

Take a ferry and discover the Bay's most beautiful Island, located one mile from Tiburon. The 740-acre mountainous island in the San Francisco Bay offers a variety of activities including hiking, biking, camping, picnicking, and tram tours. It also has some of the best views of San Francisco and the entire San Francisco Bay. Angel Island was an Immigration Station from 1910-1950, designed to control the flow of Chinese into the county.

Old St. Hilary's

201 Esperanza Street ~

Old St. Hilary's is a restored carpenter gothic church overlooking the Bay, the Tiburon Uplands Nature Preserve and the Richardson Bay Audubon Center and Sanctuary. The building is of significant architectural importance because it is one of the few remaining carpenter gothic churches to survive in its original setting. It is constructed of redwood with a douglas fir ceiling.

Railroad Ferry Museum

More than a pretty waterfront town, Tiburon has a rich railroad and maritime history, which is captured in the Railroad & Ferry Depot Museum. It has a prime shoreline location with priceless views of San Francisco, the Golden Gate Bridge, and Angel Island. The museum is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

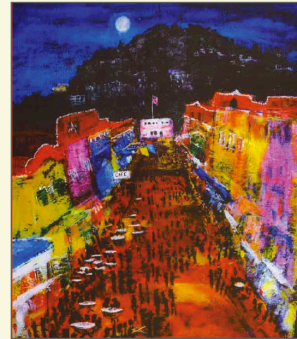
Friday Nights on Main
