DAY ONE

MORNING

The Marin Civic Center was the last commission by renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Every Wednesday at 10 a.m. you can take a docent tour of this famous facility. Or start your day with a movie matinee at the California Film Institute Rafael Theatre.

LUNCH

Dine at the historic Panama Hotel, built in 1910 and serving as an inn, restaurant, and café ever since.

AFTERNOON

Visit the Marin Museum of Contemporary Art in Novato connecting art, community, and artistic expression. It is a unique non-collecting museum that is for artists, about artists, and by artists. Over 40 artists have working studios in 3 buildings that provide an atmosphere of creative energy in which contemporary art flourishes.

DAY TWO

MORNING

Tour the working studios of artists at Artworks Downtown in San Rafael. Each tour can be tailored to your tastes and time restrictions, allowing you to discuss the works with artists who created them.

LUNCH

Enjoy authentic Parisian-style dining at L'Appart Resto in San Anselmo -a premier French restaurant and wine bar. Their delicious French food is available for daily dinners and weekend brunch and lunch, plus they also provide live music on Thursdays and wine tasting events on 1st and 3rd Tuesdays.

EVENING

Bring your evening to a close with the classic performing arts. Take in the Marin Ballet or Symphony at the Marin Veterans Memorial Auditorium in San Rafael.
